- Costs of all scheduled cultural and recreational activities

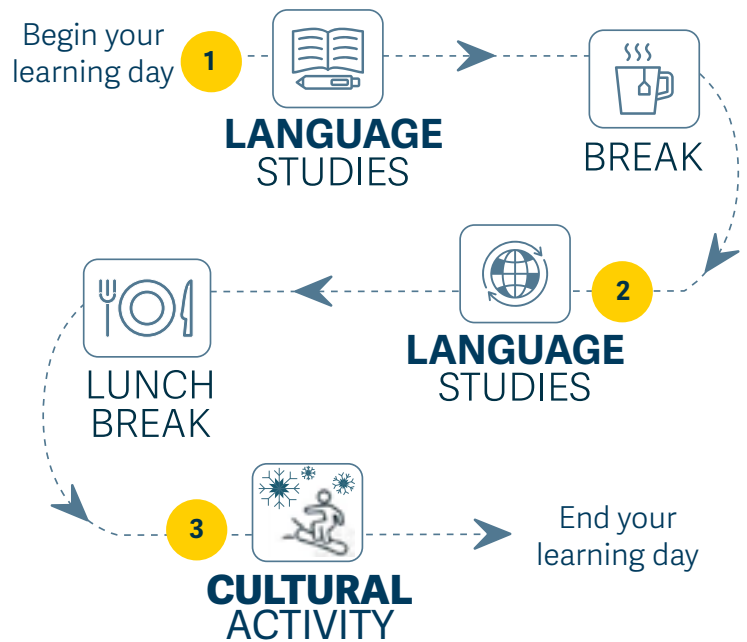
**Minimum age requirement – 16 years**
